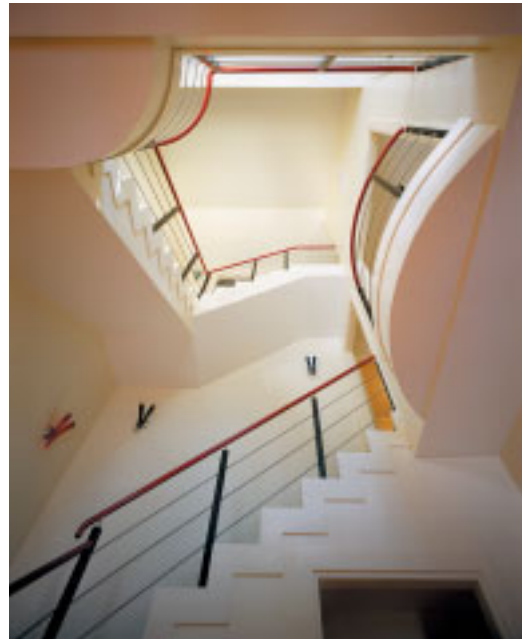
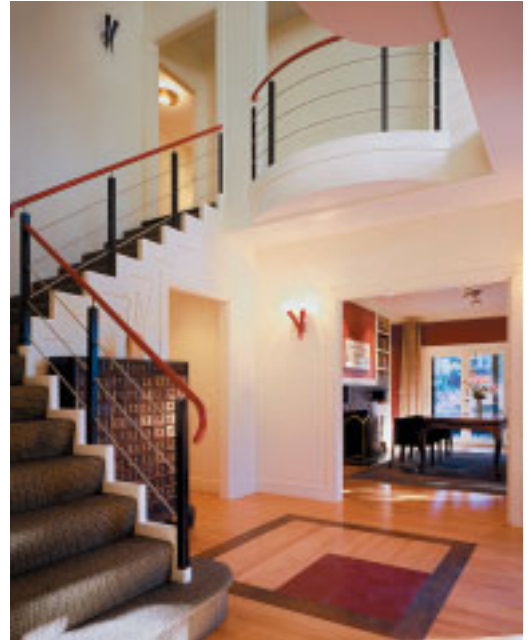
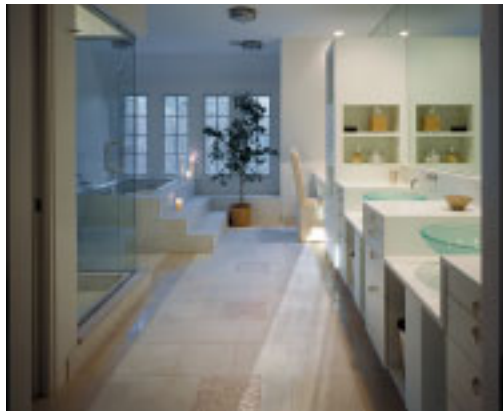
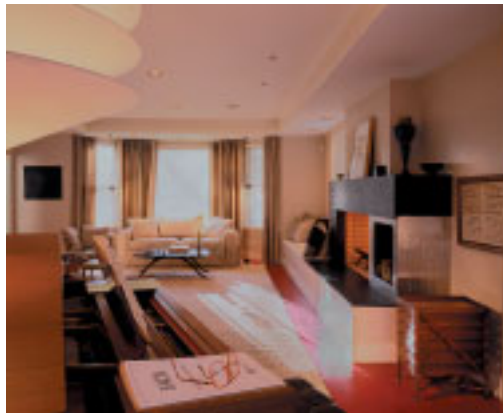


This 1890s shingle style cottage is located on a bucolic site in Newton, Massachusetts. The project consisted of a complete renovation of the structure to let light in and simplify circulation. A dramatic three-story staircase atrium was created at the heart of the house with bookcases and window seats added on a second floor landing. The interiors utilize a rich mixture of materials and textures, combined with an overall simple geometry. The house has been featured in *Boston Magazine*, *Metropolitan Home Magazine*, and the Home Section of the *Boston Globe*. Interior furnishings and finishes were developed with Celeste Cooper.
